Treasurer's Report

As of May 1, 2016, NEWC has a net worth of \$19,408 and Year to date income is \$17,985. Expenses for the fiscal year up to May 1, 2016 were \$19.962 resulting in a loss of \$1,977.

As reported in the March/April newsletter a committee has been working on identifying enhancements to the Spirit Of Wood (SOW) show scheduled for October 16, 2016.

The committee has completed the updates to the competition rules, categories and category definitions, all are available at www.newc.org> Meetings, Events & Seminars>Spirit of Wood Show. Check this information out before completing your registration form in October.

A competitors' prize has been added this year. All competitors will receive tickets for a random drawing of a non-cash prize. The number of tickets provided will be based on how many pieces each carver enters. Also, a Best in Show award, selected from the Best in Show by level winners, will be added. Non-cash prizes will be awarded for each of these winners plus the President's Award. Registration will be streamlined with an online form, the regular paper form will still be available at the event. Judges and best of award winners will be encouraged to remain in the competition area to interact with fellow carvers and visitors. If we have any volunteers a judge's critique session will be held using several competition pieces. There will be an award for the club table with the best displays and based on how well they engage visitors. We are also planning a non-competition table for members who wish to show their work but not enter the competition. Finally, your Board of Directors and SOW committee need your help. The SOW is not the board's or committee's show, it is the members' show. NEWC has the largest and best show in New England, pulling that off takes a committed group of people. If our plans are to be successful we need your help. Jim Hayden is the SOW Chair and Ken Wagner has signed on to be the Competition Chair, we still need a Co-Chair plus many others to help set up and tear down, provide security, assist in registration and check out at the end of the show, and many other tasks. If members do not step up we may not be able to implement all of the planned enhancements. In fact without your help we may see the SOW slowly wither away. That would be a tragedy for us all. So when you are asked to help say, sure how can I help make the SOW successful. It will not happen without you!

Jim has announced that this will be his last show (after 5 years) as SOW chairman, so we do need to get some extra help.
